

Quick Tips for the Shop - Choosing a Countersink Bit



Single-Fluted Countersink

A simple paint can opener can be the perfect tool for cleaning chips and debris out of a mortise. All it takes is a little bit of filing on the end of the hook to create a sharp joinery tool for your shop.



Multi-Fluted Countersink

An inexpensive nail apron makes a perfect roll-up pouch for storing spade bits in the shop. And with a little help from a sewing machine, you can create a custom-sized pocket for each bit.



Zero-Fluted

A small shot of hot-melt glue does a nice job of sealing the ends of caulking tubes between jobs. It's a quick way to prevent the contents from drying out.
